

Bulletin Boards

[There is to be] a bulletin board [in the Central Committee office] showing [current Democratic presidential] candidates, information about their campaign committees, and the Central Committee liaisons [The Central Committee will also have] one type of literature for each candidate.

Adopted by the Montgomery County Democratic Central Committee, August 27, 1975

Precinct chairs may accept advertisements for Democratic primary or general election candidates in precinct newsletters provided that: (1) all candidates are charged the same rate for that newsletter, (2) all such advertisements must be clearly labeled as paid advertisements (having a "by authority of" line is not sufficient), (3) somewhere in the newsletter, there must be a list of all of the Democratic candidates running for the office that was featured in the advertisement, and (4) the Treasurer of the Central Committee must be notified in advance that the precinct will be accepting advertisements. A list of all precincts accepting advertisements shall be posted on a bulletin board in a prominent place in the Party Headquarters and the information shall also be included in the Party's World Wide Web site.

The Assistant Secretary shall:

6. see to it that the bulletin boards in the County Democratic Party Headquarters are properly maintained including the material required to be posted in accordance with the policies adopted by the Central Committee on August 27, 1975 (information on presidential candidates) and June 9, 1998 (list of precincts accepting advertisements in their newsletters);
