1. Computer Committee

A task force is formed to monitor the Montgomery County Democratic Central Committee's computer needs and servicings.

Adopted by the Montgomery County Democratic Central Committee, March 17, 1971

2. Purchase of Computers

Any computer accepted by the MCDCC should be union made.

Adopted by the Montgomery County Democratic Central Committee, October 20, 1983

3. Computer Use Guidelines

OPERATION

1. The Central Committee Secretary and Office Manager will control and authorize all access to the computer. No person will operate the computer without their approval.
2. The computer will normally not be used at night to print out information. Night-time work, developing programs and entering data, will only be done with the approval of the Central Committee Chairman, Secretary and/or Office Manager.
3. The computer will not be used at night during any year in which there is a gubernatorial primary election until after the primary.
